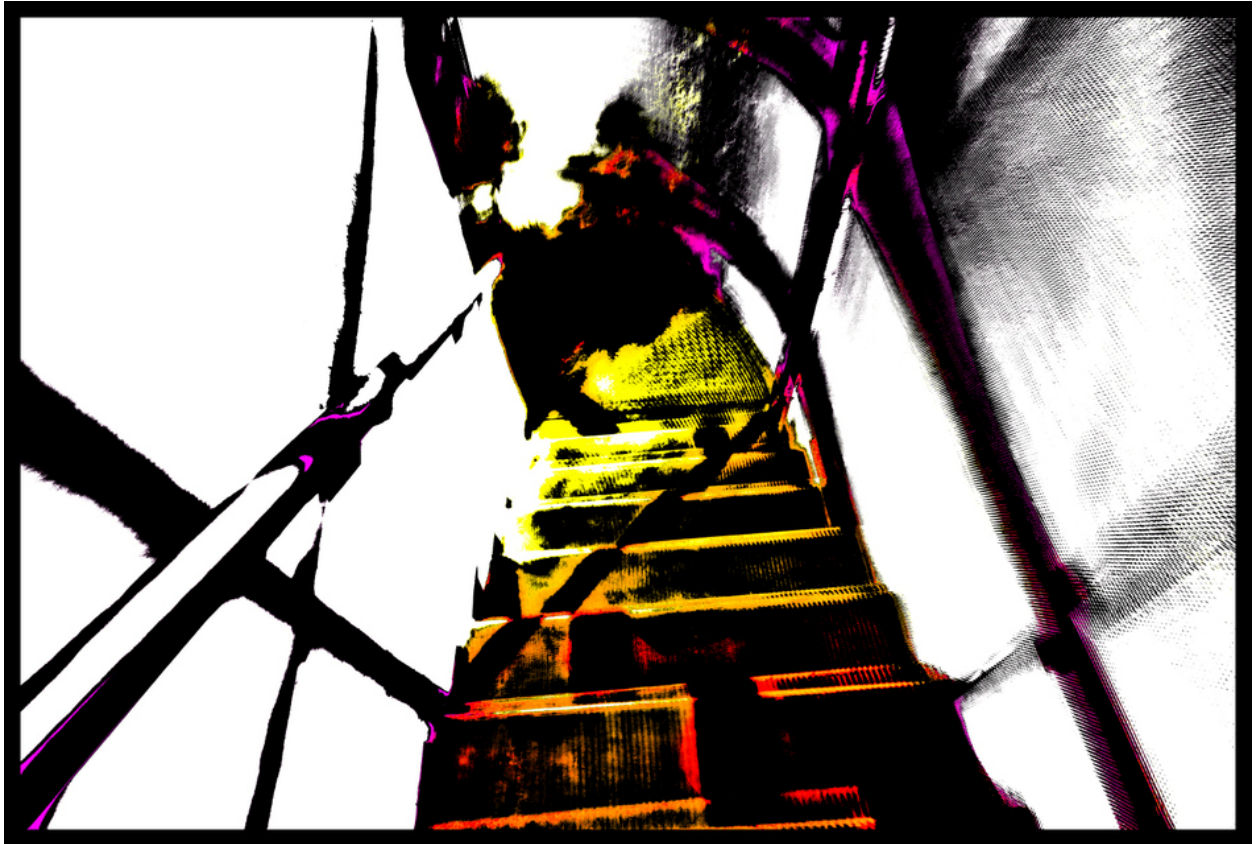

Analysis¹⁾
