## Picture Description<sup>1)</sup>

## Analysis<sup>1)</sup>

This photograph, with its dramatic interplay of light and shadow, presents a close-up perspective of weathered wood. A roughly hewn post, fastened with metal screws, commands the foreground, its surface etched with age and texture.
