### Picture Description<sup>1)</sup>

Reflection of a construction site, featuring scaffolding and a crane, mirrored in a wet, pebbled surface.

### Analysis<sup>1)</sup>

This photograph presents an inverted perspective of a construction site reflected in a rain puddle. The composition is dominated by the abstract texture of the water's surface, which distorts and fragments the images of a building under construction and a tall crane. The scene is lit by a soft, diffused light, enhancing the dreamlike and surreal quality of the reflection. The juxtaposition of the industrial landscape and the ephemeral nature of the water creates a compelling visual tension, inviting the viewer to contemplate the relationship between the built environment and the natural world.
