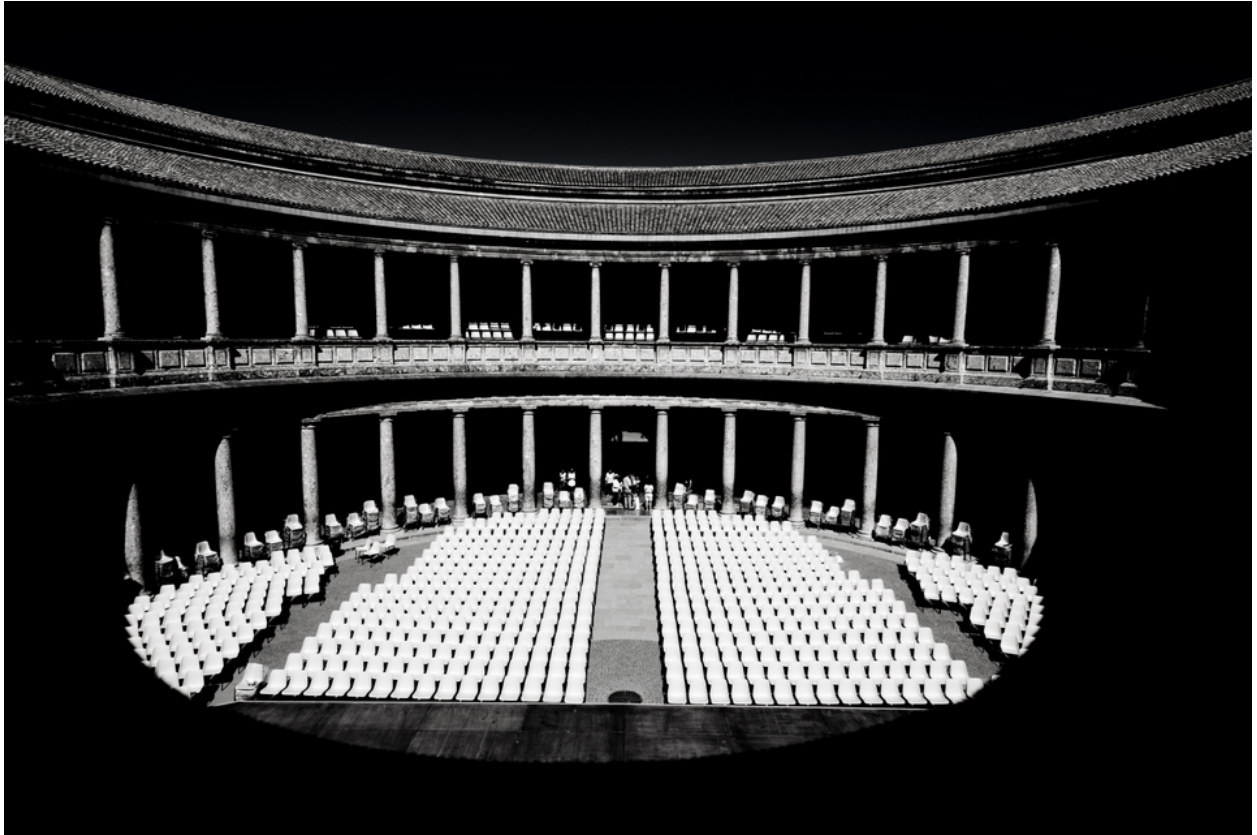

Analysis¹⁾

This photograph captures the stark beauty of an outdoor amphitheater, rendered in a high-contrast black and white.
