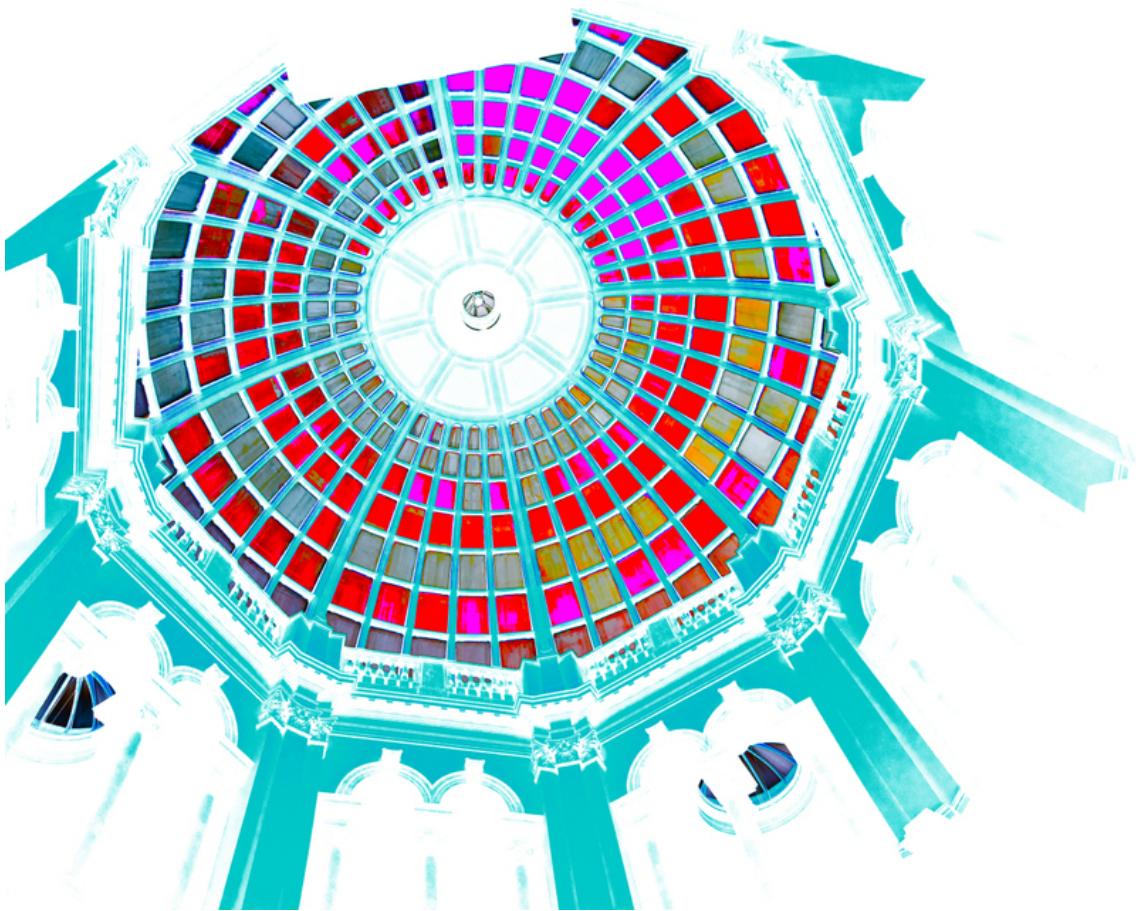

Analysis¹⁾
