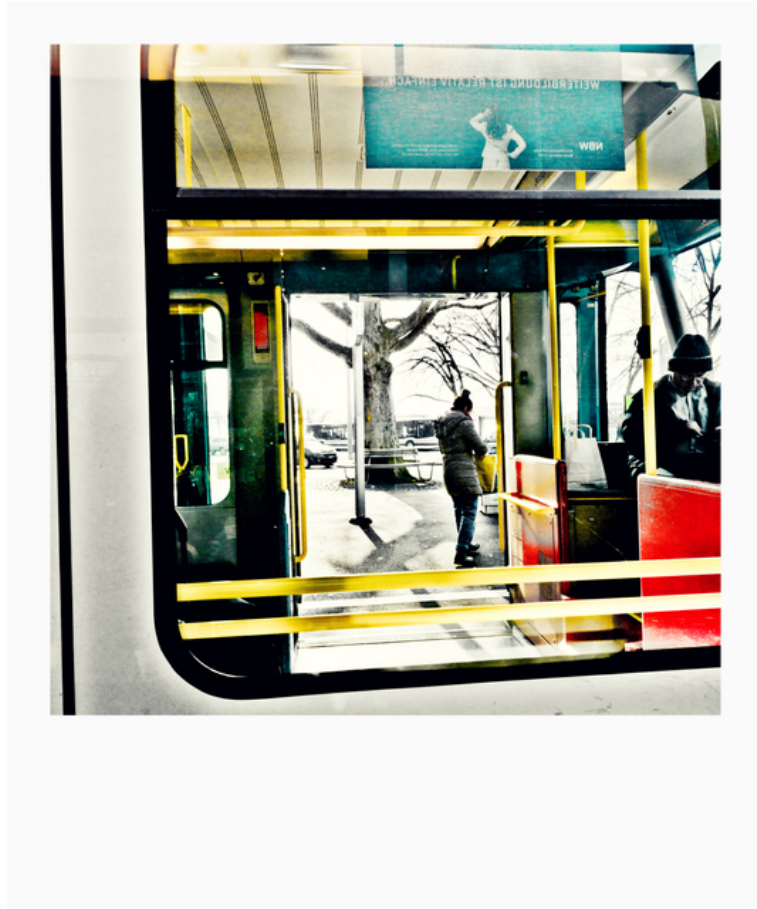

Picture Description¹⁾

Analysis¹⁾

This photograph, captured with an eye for urban detail, presents a scene from within a public transit vehicle, possibly a tram or bus.
