Analysis¹⁾

This dramatic, low-angle perspective captures the imposing presence of New York City's architecture. The stark monochrome palette accentuates the geometric forms of the skyscrapers, emphasizing their height and mass. A sense of awe and perhaps even claustrophobia is evoked by the looming buildings, which seem to converge towards a central point in the sky.
