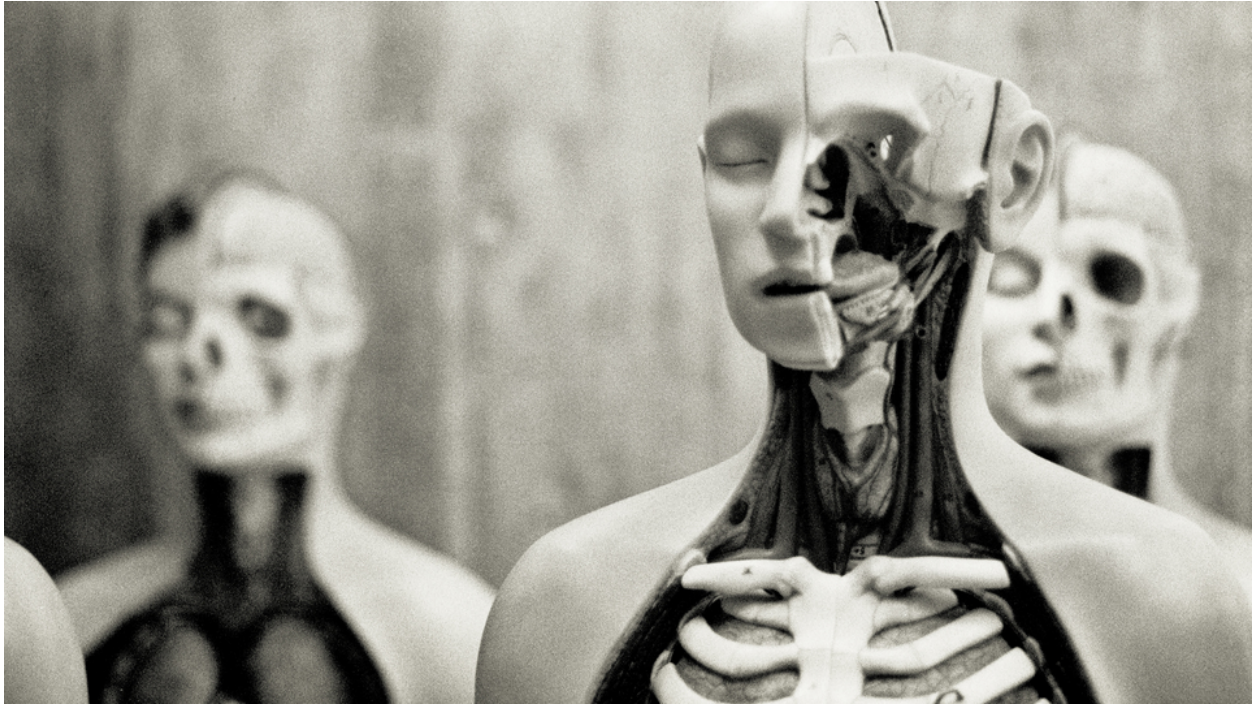

Picture Description¹⁾
