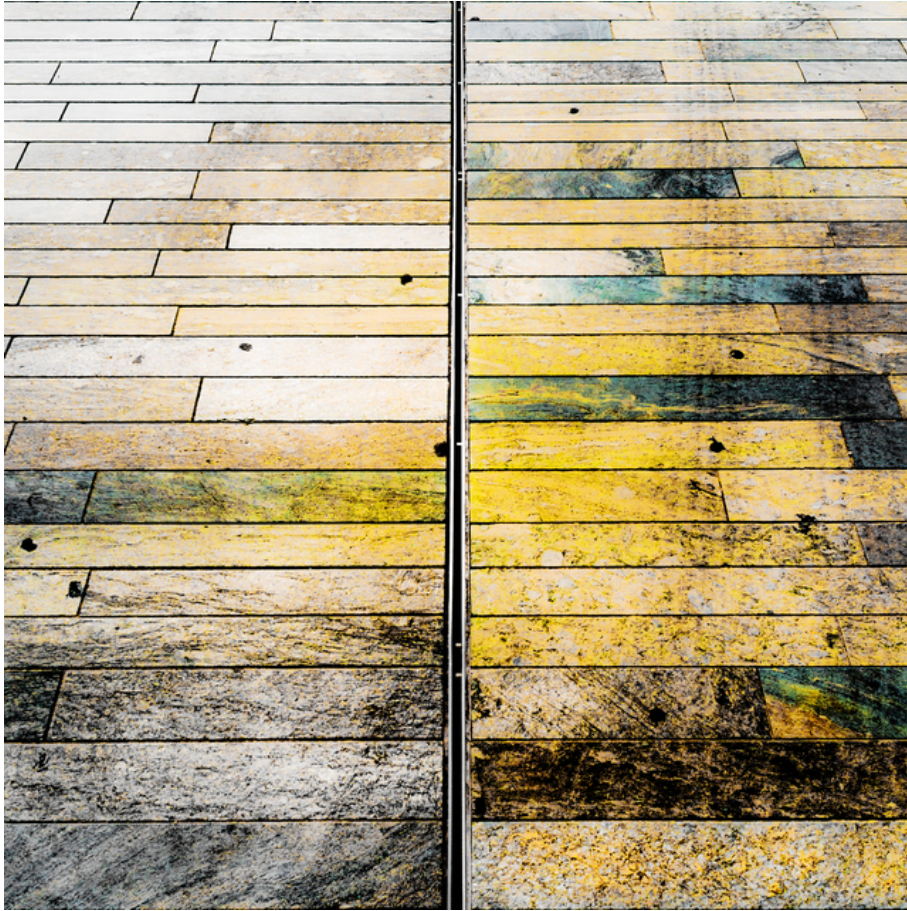

Analysis¹⁾
